Aimed at **consultant colorectal surgeons** and **theatre practitioners**, this intensive 2 day practical course is an **anatomy-based skills** and **operating-team orientated** course on **human cadavers** run in a state-of-the-art training facility. The Department of Anatomy and the newly opened Clinical Anatomy Suite occupies the Bristol Veterinary School building situated adjacent to St. Michael's Hospital in the centre of Bristol. Facilities include dissection table with touch screen monitors for e-learning, as well as an open access IT suite.

The aim of the course is to develop the skills needed and familiarization of anatomy required for safe and effective laparoscopic resection of colorectal cancer. Consultant delegates are expected to be enrolled on the National Training Programme and should have already developed the laparoscopic skills required by attending suitable, recognized courses. The course will include:

- **Hands-on training** for Laparoscopic Colorectal Surgical Techniques
- **Expert faculty** of experienced laparoscopic surgeons
- Expert video demonstrations of **key steps for LCS procedures**
- Overview of surgical **Enhanced Recovery Programme**
- Advice and guidance for LCS **theatre practitioners**
- Maximum of **8 delegates** (on 4 workstations)

and will **provide a team approach** with '**breakout sessions**' for nurse training.
